Day 1 December 26, Thursday: Depart for Rome

Depart New York JFK International Airport via Alitalia Airlines for our overnight flight to Rome, Italy. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served on board. (D,B)

Day 2 December 27, Friday: Arrive in Rome | Assisi

Arrive at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet our Peter's Way Tours tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Our luggage will be transferred to a comfortable touring bus and soon, we will be on our way through the gentle Umbrian hills to Assisi. After a two-hour ride, we will arrive at the town dedicated to St. Francis, the young friar who turned to God and established an order that has grown stronger over the centuries. Visit and celebrate Mass at the **Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli**. After Mass, we'll visit this great Basilica, built in 1569 and crowned by Alessi's magnificent dome. It encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula," or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the saint died. We will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom.

Check-in at our hotel in Assisi and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi. (D)

Day 3 December 28, Saturday: Sites of St. Francis and St. Clare

Early morning, walk to the Basilica of St. Francis to celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Francis. Return to our hotel for breakfast.

After breakfast, our local guide will take us to explore the Basilica complex, which is actually composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower basilica dates from 1228 to 1230 and is richly decorated with beautiful stained glass windows and paintings done by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper basilica, built from 1230 - 1253, we will marvel at the monumental frescoes painted by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of the saint. Continuing on, we'll visit the Basilica of St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement. View her remains and see the miraculous Crucifix.

Independent lunch and afternoon at leisure. Perhaps you would like to visit Piazza del Comune; Chiesa Nuova; the home and cloth workshops of Pietro Bernadone and Lady Pica (St. Francis' parents); the home of Favorino and Ortolana Schifi (St. Clare's parents); or Bishop's Palace, in front of which Francis stripped his clothes and gave them to his father.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi. (B,D)

Day 4 December 29, Sunday: Orvieto | Rome

After breakfast at our hotel, we'll leave Assisi to visit Orvieto, an Etruscan city located in the scenic region of Umbria, between Florence and Rome. Its chief attraction is the cathedral, begun in 1290 to shelter the relics of the Miracle of Bolsena (Miracle of the Host). Upon arrival, celebrate Mass at the Shrine. After Mass we will have a guided tour of the magnificent 13th-century church with its marble exterior of alternating black and white stripes. In one of the side chapels are frescos by Luca Signorelli. Independent lunch in Orvieto.

Late afternoon, we'll continue to Rome, the "Eternal City". We'll see over 2,500 years of history from the Roman ruins to 15th century churches, 17th century palaces, and 20th century monuments. Check in at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 5 December 30, Monday: Tour of Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel & St. Peter's Basilica | Optional Scavi Tour

After an early breakfast at our hotel, walk to St. Peter's Basilica to celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter (subject to confirmation) or one of the Grotto Chapels.

After Mass, visit one of the great art collections in the world, the Vatican Museums. Walk in the footsteps of the Princes of the Church through the richly decorated galleries. Continue on to the Sistine Chapel, the private chapel of the Popes, where Michelangelo best expressed his genius in monumental frescoes. End our morning tour in St. Peter's Basilica. Take in the awesome architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the new tomb of St. John Paul II, in St. Sebastian's Chapel. On your own, with time permitting, you may wish to go to the Vatican Crypt to see and pray near the tomb of St. Peter. Independent lunch.

This is your opportunity to explore the sights, sounds, and tastes of Rome all on your own! Perhaps you will want to buy religious articles in preparation for the Papal Blessing at the audience on Wednesday. Or you may want to treat yourself to a leisurely multi-course lunch in a quaint trattoria. There are always plenty of churches, museums, piazzas and ancient ruins to explore.

Tour of the Scavi* (Subject to confirmation): The Scavi, or Vatican Necropolis, is the underground excavation under St. Peter's Basilica. In 1939, Pope Pius XII

ordered an excavation beneath the grotto of St. Peter's Basilica, where many popes are buried. Among the tombs of pagans and early Christians, far beneath the high altar of St. Peter's, excavators found a shrine amid the rubble. Most scholars concur that the small column is part of a second-century A.D. shrine built by Rome's small Christian community on the site where St. Peter was buried.

*All tours of the Scavi are subject to confirmation by the Vatican Office two weeks prior to departure. Tours run continually, are one hour in length, and are limited to 12-15 persons.

Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

Day 6 December 31, Tuesday: Papal Basilicas of Rome

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Making pilgrimages to Christian sacred sites in Rome is a custom predating the first Holy Year in 1280. Today we will visit the pilgrim basilicas of Rome. We'll begin with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major Basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (AD 432-440). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics in the nave depicting scenes from the Old Testament. Pray near the relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem. View the icon Salus Populi Romani, believed to be painted by St. Luke and meaning "Protectress of the Roman People." The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major.** Next, visit the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. It was founded by the Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and was home to the Popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. From there, we'll pass by the Holy Stairs. These are said to be the steps on which Christ walked on His way to Pilate's palace. You can go up on your knees as thousands of pilgrims have done in reverently recalling the sufferings of Christ. Then, we will visit the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem, which houses fragments of the true cross brought to Rome by St. Helena, mother of Constantine. Independent lunch.

This evening, walk to St. Peter's Square to witness the blessing of the Vatican Christmas Crèche by Pope Francis (followed by the Te Deum).

Dinner at our hotel. After dinner, perhaps you would like to take part in the New Year's activities in the city center.

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 7 January 1, Wednesday: Papal Mass for the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God | Tour of Imperial Rome

Early breakfast at our hotel. **This morning, walk to St. Peter's Basilica to attend the Papal Mass for the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, celebrated by Pope Francis.** Independent lunch.

Visit the Church of St. Peter in Chains to see the original chains in which St. Peter was brought captive to Rome and the statue of Moses, one of Michelangelo's greatest masterpieces. Visit the ancient Roman Forum and visit the area around the Colosseum for an explanation of its fascinating history. We will also see the grandiose white marble monument of King Victor Emmanuel II, often called the "Wedding Cake." See the Trajan Column and the Market (the ancient Roman equivalent of a department store).

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 8 January 2, Thursday: Tour of the Basilica of St. Paul and the Catacombs | Walking Tour of Historic Rome | Farewell Dinner

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will have a unique tour of Rome and her outskirts. Drive past Tiberina Island, the Aventine Hill, the pyramid of Caius Cestius, and St. Paul's Gate, part of the ancient Aurelian Wall. Stop to visit the magnificent Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. Surrounding the nave are the medallions of each Pope throughout history. Then, drive along a section of the Old Appian Way, one of the first ancient Roman military roads, which connected Rome to Naples and Brindisi on the Adriatic coast. You can see the huge slabs that originally paved its length and several surviving Patrician tombs that once lined its way, including the massive tomb of Cecilia Metella. Visit the Catacombs, the maze of tunnels hollowed out of volcanic rock where early Christians secretly practiced their religious rites and buried their dead. **Celebrate Mass in the Catacombs.** Independent lunch.

Enjoy a walking tour to experience the best of ancient Rome. Begin at Piazza di Spagna, one of the most famous squares in Rome. From the Fontana della Barcaccia (Fountain of the Old Boat), in the middle of the piazza, climb the famous Spanish Steps to the top. Continue to the Trevi Fountain and toss in a coin. Our next stop is the Pantheon. Built more than 1800 years ago, the magnificent Pantheon still stands as a reminder of the great Roman Empire. The name Pantheon refers to the building's original function as a temple for all the gods. When approaching the front of the Pantheon, you can still see the original Latin inscription by Marcus Agrippa. Continue on to the lively Piazza Navona, the Church of St. Agnes, and Bernini's fountain. Time will be given to browse through the artists' stalls or relax and enjoy one of Rome's most famous products, a tartufo at the Gelateria Tre Scalini.

Our farewell dinner will be at a restaurant in Rome. Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and friendship, and taste the Mediterranean cuisine in a typical Roman setting with wine and music.

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 9 January 3, Friday: Return from Rome

After a buffet breakfast, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo Da Vinci Airport for our return flight home. (B)

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If a final payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: The \$350.00 tour deposit is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury. Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. We do not refund costs associated with tour services that are not utilized.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation based on availability. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: It is the traveler's responsibility to have a valid passport for international travel. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all required documents are complete and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents, including passports.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from New York. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). If you purchase independent connecting flights, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not independently purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed by Peter's Way Tours for travel.**

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. However, there is no guarantee that requests will be honored. Peter's Way cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available for purchase (contact our office to inquire). Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The estimated Land Only package cost is \$2,995.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$100 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include any portion of the group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book all segments independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying Peter's Way Tours in writing, up to 100 days prior to date of departure. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the group flight arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with special requests. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure (additional fees will apply). An increase in airfare may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage, per person, is included at most hotels.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on two persons sharing a hotel room with two twin beds and private facilities. Married couples may request a double bed, however, double beds are subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, however, there is no discount for triple occupancy. **Single rooms are limited and may be requested at time of booking. If confirmed, an additional charge of \$695.00 will apply.** We will make every effort to accommodate roommate requests, but we cannot guarantee double occupancy. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Breakfast daily plus six (6) dinners, including a festive farewell dinner in Rome.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; €2 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; and €1.50 Euro per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff

after each meal and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
