



Day 1 August 19, Sunday: Depart for Ireland

Today depart New York's JFK Airport on Aer Lingus for our overseas journey to Ireland.

Complimentary meals and beverages will be served aloft. (D,B)

Day 2 August 20, Monday: Arrive in Shannon | Galway | Corrib River Cruise | Westport

Morning arrival at Shannon Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and our Peter's Way Tours tour manager/guide will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus, and we will be on our way to **Galway**, the capital of the west, affectionately known as "The City of the Tribes." Independent stop will be made for tea, coffee and scones. Upon arrival in Galway, enjoy a Corrib Cruise. This journey on the Corrib Princess takes passengers along the majestic River Corrib and onto the lake, providing visitors with wonderful views of the historic monuments and natural amenities that make this one of the most spectacular waterways in Ireland. Independent lunch. After lunch, we continue to Westport for hotel check-in. **Celebrate Mass at St. Mary's Church in Westport.** Dinner and overnight at hotel in Westport. (D)

Day 3 August 21, Tuesday: Connemara | Kylemore Abbey | Knock

Irish breakfast at hotel. This morning, travel through the **Connemara Region** described by Oscar Wilde as "savage beauty." The landscape ranges from rugged mountains, brooding lakes, windswept bogs and stretches of white sandy beaches. This is the country of *The Quiet Man* and *The Purple Taxi* – two famous films made in this region. Its picturesque fishing villages, small farms with stone walls, thatched cottages, and heather covered hills create an unforgettable scene. Connemara is steeped in a history of poverty and great wealth. Visit the majestic **Kylemore Abbey**, originally built by a wealthy English doctor, Mitchell Henry, as a gift to his wife. The house came into the hands of Benedictine religious sisters in 1920 who used the building as a boarding school for girls until 2008. Enjoy a tour of the Abbey, situated in a romantic setting of great beauty. Independent lunch. Continue to Knock, where the Apparition of August 1879 transformed an ordinary village in Co. Mayo, into an international Marian Shrine. Experience the many customs and traditions observed in Knock. Many pilgrims bring Holy Water from the Shrine home to loved ones. Pray the Stations of the Cross and the Rosary. Spend quiet time before the Blessed Sacrament or visit one of the sacred spaces designed for prayer. The Chapel of Reconciliation is open weekdays from 11am – 4pm. **Celebrate Mass in the Apparition Chapel.** After Mass, explore the shrine's religious goods shops, Knock Museum and shrine café. Return to Westport.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Westport. (B,D)

Day 4 August 22, Wednesday: Burren Region | Cliffs of Moher | Bunnary Castle Queenship of Mary

Irish breakfast at hotel. This morning, we will take a drive through the spectacular Burren. The term "Burren" is derived from the Gaelic for "stony place". The Burren is famous not just because of its beautiful limestone landscapes but also because of the remarkable flora of the region and its rich archaeological heritage. Stop at the **Cliffs of Moher**, the most majestic scene in Ireland. The Cliffs of Moher stand 702 feet at their highest point and stretch along the Atlantic coast for five miles.

From this height, on a clear day one can see the Aran Islands and Galway Bay. Independent lunch. Continue to Limerick for hotel check-in. **Celebrate Mass in Limerick.** This evening, enjoy a **Medieval banquet at Bunnary Castle and Folk Park.** We will be greeted by a kilted piper, then cross over the drawbridge and join the Earl of Thomond for a festive banquet at this majestic 15th century castle. Enjoy an evening filled with music, excellent food, drink and cheer! Overnight at hotel in Limerick. (B,D)

Day 5 August 23, Thursday: Clonmacnoise | Dublin

Irish breakfast at hotel. This morning, we leave Limerick to visit Clonmacnoise, a monastery founded by St. Ciaran in 548-9. Dermot, a local prince, helped Ciaran build his first church on the site and later when Dermot was elected High King he richly endowed the monastery. Although St. Ciaran did not live long after the foundation, the monastery grew rapidly. It was plundered six times between 834 and 1012, and burned 26 times between 841 and 1204. Clonmacnoise was a great centre of learning, and many manuscripts, including the Annals of Tighermach (11th century) and the Book of the Dun Cow (12th century), were written here. The Normans attacked Clonmacnoise in 1179, and burned 105 houses, and for the next four hundred years the monastery was often plundered. In 1552 the English garrison from Athlone took all the monastic valuables away. The monastic site never recovered from this attack. The on-site guides provide excellent tours to the many interesting artefacts to be found here, including the High Crosses, the 12th century round tower, and the many Churches and Temples, which adorn this hallowed site. **Celebrate Mass at Clonmacnoise.** Independent lunch. Continue to Dublin. Upon arrival, check in at hotel and the afternoon is free to participate in the day's events of the World Meeting of Families. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Dublin. (B,D)

Day 6 August 24, Friday: Dublin | RDS Arena, WMF Congress site

Irish breakfast at hotel. **9th World Meeting of Families Congress events include daily celebration of the Eucharist, prayerful activities, keynote speakers, workshops and exhibitions. Each day will reflect on the theme "The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World" chosen by the Holy Father (full program to be advised at a later date).** Dinner and overnight at hotel in Dublin. (B,D)

Day 7 August 25, Saturday: Morning Tour of Dublin | Festival of Families

Irish breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, discover Dublin's "Fair City." **Highlights of Dublin Tour** includes the famous 'Doors of Dublin,' the elegant Georgian squares, Phoenix Park, Trinity College, to view the 8th century illustrated manuscript, The Book of Kells, followed by a visit to St. Patrick's Cathedral, the largest church in Ireland. The site of St. Patrick's Cathedral is said to be the earliest Christian site in Ireland, where St. Patrick baptized converts. Transfer to WMF Congress site. This evening opens the **Festival of Families**, where we will gather to celebrate the gift of family from the perspective of the specific theme of the World Meeting. This will be a cultural celebration of music, dance, song, within a prayerful and joyful setting, and with the aid of stories given by families representing the five continents. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Dublin. (B,D)

Day 8 August 26, Sunday: 9th World Meeting of Families Closing and Eucharistic Celebration with the Holy Father

Irish breakfast at hotel. **The 9th World Meeting of Families 2018 will conclude with a Solemn Mass in thanksgiving to God, the Holy Trinity for the gift of family and for its sanctification. (Details to be advised at a later date).** Independent lunch. The remainder of the afternoon is free to explore Dublin on your own. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Dublin. (B,D)

Day 9 August 27, Monday: Return from Dublin

After breakfast, we will be transferred by coach to Dublin Airport for

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or credit/debit card. Package prices are \$100.00 higher per person when using a credit/debit card as form of payment as the package price shown on the brochure reflects a cash discount. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is there is a \$350.00 non-refundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a non-refundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are non-refundable upon receipt. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late reservation fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on the brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least the duration of your visit. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed, current and in good condition. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Tentative round trip on **Aer Lingus from New York's JFK International Airport** (Subject to confirmation by September 25, 2017). Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the land only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. **All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently.** A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (estimated \$2,695.00 per person sharing a twin room, subject to confirmation by September 25, 2017) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Matrimonial (full) bedded rooms are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms are available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or matrimonial (full) bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an estimated additional charge of \$750.00. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single

room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and dinner daily. Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities to the tour manager, guides and driver are included in your tour package. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges/local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave 1.00 Euro per person for the waiters after each meal and 1.00 Euro per person per day for the maid/bell boys.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: All passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others as our pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, which may involve stairs, hills, cobblestone roads and uneven pavement. Additionally, most motor coaches are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. It is each passenger's responsibility to be aware of his or her limits with regard to travel and group activities. Any person with a disability requiring special attention must advise Peter's Way Tours of the situation at time of enrollment. A qualified companion must accompany any passenger requiring special assistance. Peter's Way Tours will make reasonable attempts to accommodate disabled passengers with special needs, but shall not be held responsible in the event we are unable to do so. Moreover, Peter's Way Tours is not responsible for the denial of services by any carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is strongly recommended that all participants purchase insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for non-refundable payments, damaged luggage or trip interruption. Peter's Way Tours offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan that provides coverage for pre-paid travel arrangements made through Peter's Way Tours. These benefits and services help insure the well being of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The insurance premium is based on total package price, including taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc. **The insurance premium for total package prices from \$0 to \$1000.00 is \$100; \$1001.00 to \$2000.00 is \$175; \$2001.00 to \$3000.00 is \$225; \$3001.00 to \$4000.00 is \$250; \$4001.00 to \$5000.00 is \$275; and \$5001.00 and over is 6% of total package price.
