Message from our Pastor

Recently Bishop Brennan spoke to the Pastors about the process of restarting the distribution of the Precious Blood at mass. I would like to try it and see how it goes. But there are realities and truths we need to reflect upon before we start. “This is the one who came by water and blood—Jesus Christ. He did not come by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit who testifies because the Spirit is the truth. For there are three that testify: the Spirit, the water, and the blood; and the three are in agreement.” 1 John 5:6-8

We believe that at mass Jesus is fully present in the Eucharist. Body and blood, soul, and divinity. However, one consecrated species is not greater or more than the other. You can receive one or the other and you receive the fullness of the presence of Jesus. Only the priest, as celebrant, needs to receive both Eucharistic Species to complete the mass sacrifice for the mass to be valid. So, no one else “Needs” to receive both the Eucharistic Body and Blood at mass, but it is a beautiful personal devotion to do so. There are practical realities to do as a community before we start distribution under both species again as a community.

1- The extra ordinary minister of communion is, extra. Only the priest, bishop, deacon, and seminarian who has received the diocese ministry of acolyte is the ordinary minister. The main purpose of the extra ordinary minister of holy communion is to assist the priest and community by bringing holy communion to the sick. That is their primary purpose. Helping at communion time, while beautiful and good, is secondary.

2- As it has been a few years since we have had communion under both kinds, everyone needs recertification and needs new training to be a parish extra ordinary minister of communion. Even if you were trained before you will need to be trained again.

3- When we start this we are going to go slow and if necessary we will suspend again the practice of communion under both kinds.

4- We will only offer communion for both kinds at the following Sunday masses. St. Gerard Majella 8:15 and 9:45 am. At Incarnation 8:00 am and noon. We will also only have one station, one chalice. And we ask that everyone uses hand sanitizer before receiving it.

5- It will be some time until we start this devotion again because we need people to sign up for the training, and Virtus certification. Only those who are in full communion can do this ministry. That means received baptism, first communion, reconciliation, and confirmation. The person must be at least a senior in High School or 18 years old. And if they are married that means they are married in the church and they are not just civilly married or living with someone who is not their spouse.





Veterans Day originated as “Armistice Day” on Nov. 11, 1919, the first anniversary of the end of World War I. Congress passed a resolution in 1926 making it an annual observance, and it became a national holiday in 1938. Sixteen years later, then-President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed legislation changing the name to Veterans Day to honor all those who served their country during war or peacetime. On this day, the nation honors military veterans — living and dead — with parades and other observances across the country and a ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier at Arlington National Cemetery in Virginia.

Mensaje de nuestro Párroco

RE-ENTRENAMIENTO PARA MINISTROS DE LA SAGRADA COMUNIÓN

Recientemente el Obispo Brennan habló a los párrocos sobre el proceso de reiniciar la distribución de la Preciosa Sangre en la misa. Me gustaría intentarlo y ver cómo va. Pero hay realidades y verdades sobre las que debemos reflexionar antes de empezar.

"Este es el que vino por agua y sangre: Jesucristo. No vino sólo por agua, sino por agua y sangre. Y el Espíritu es el que da testimonio, porque el Espíritu es la verdad. Porque tres son los que dan testimonio: el Espíritu, el agua y la sangre; y los tres están de acuerdo". (1 Juan 5:6-8).

Creemos que en la misa Jesús está plenamente presente en la Eucaristía. Cuerpo y sangre, alma y divinidad. Sin embargo, una especie consagrada no es mayor o más que la otra. Se puede recibir una u otra y recibe la plenitud de la presencia de Jesús. Sólo el sacerdote, como celebrante, necesita recibir ambas Especies Eucarísticas para completar el sacrificio de la misa para que la misa sea válida. Por lo tanto, nadie más "necesita" recibir tanto el Cuerpo Eucarístico como la Sangre en la misa, pero es una hermosa devoción personal hacerlo. Hay realidades prácticas que hacer como comunidad antes de volver a distribuir bajo ambas especies como comunidad.

1- El ministro extra ordinario de la comunión es, extra. Sólo es ministro *ordinario* el sacerdote, el obispo, el diácono y el seminarista que ha recibido el ministerio diocesano de acólito. La finalidad principal del ministro extra ordinario de la Sagrada Comunión es ayudar al sacerdote y a la comunidad llevando la Sagrada Comunión a los enfermos. Ese es su objetivo principal. Ayudar en el momento de la comunión, aunque hermoso y bueno, es secundario.

2- Como han pasado cuatro años desde que no hemos tenido la Comunión bajo las dos especies, todos los ministros extraordinarios necesitan recertificación y nueva formación para ser ministros extra ordinarios de la Comunión. Incluso si usted fue entrenado antes, usted tendrá que ser entrenado nuevamente.

3- Cuando empecemos este proceso vamos a ir despacio y si es necesario suspenderemos de nuevo la práctica de la comunión bajo las dos especies.

4-Sólo ofreceremos la comunión bajo las dos especies en las siguientes misas dominicales. En San Gerardo Majella 8:15 y 9:45 am. En la Encarnación 8:00 am y mediodía. También sólo tendremos una estación, un cáliz. Y pedimos que todos usen desinfectante de manos antes de recibirla.

5- Pasará algún tiempo hasta que empecemos de nuevo esta devoción porque es necesario que los interesados se apunten para la formación, y la certificación de *Virtus*. Sólo los que están en plena comunión pueden desempeñar este ministerio. Eso significa haber recibido el Bautismo, la Primera Comunión, la Reconciliación y la Confirmación. La persona debe estar al menos en el último año de la escuela secundaria o tener 18 años. Y si están casados significa que estén casados por la Iglesia y no solamente casados civilmente o viviendo en concubinato.




