Message from Our Pastor December 3rd 2023

As part of the process of merger Bishop Brennan has asked for suggestions for the new name of the new parish. Both individual site churches will always keep their name and identity, Incarnation will always be Incarnation Church and St Gerard Shrine will also always be a Shrine but the united corporate/canonical new parish will have its own name. (Incarnation Academy will also not change its name or governance structure in this process). It will be in the end the Bishop Brennan's decision as to a name but he has asked me for input. So I am asking all of you for input, prayer, and ideas as to possible new intercessors.

The bp criterion for this is a name, or event, and an explanation as to why it would build up the identity of both sites and people. Remember this new parish will be our outside public identity for hundreds of years to come and it should not be a name that currently already exists as a parish in our diocese.

There is the possibility he could choose Incarnation-St Gerard as the name. But he wanted more choices done in prayer. A few names that came to me in prayer and a few that others suggested so far are:

-St Gianna Molla

A saint from the 1960-70s who was canonized by St John Paul II in the late 1990s. She was an Italian wife and mother. A Doctor by profession. A lay women very active in her local parish who ran bible studies and helped in marriage prep and Rel Ed. Upon conceiving her last child she was told by her doctor that something was very wrong and she had to either abort her unborn child or she would die soon after child birth. Being a Doctor she understood the biology and science and accepted the reality of the situation. After praying with her husband and other children and local priests they choose life. She chose to have the baby girl. A few days after the babies healthy birth she passed away. That girl- also Gianna - is still alive as is her husband and other children and talk about the powerful witness, vocation, and intercession from heaven of Gianna. St Gianna is a patron saint of life and thus like Mary said yes to life and is linked to St Gerard as an intercessor for pregnant women.

-Our Savior

Simply, Jesus Our Lord. There can be no greater intercessor.

-St Monica

Monica was the mother of Saint Augustine, Bishop and Doctor of the Church from the 4th century. She prayed for the moral and spiritual conversion of her sons, she had two, her entire life. And both converted. Augustine when from an atheist who lived a very questionable moral life to a Christian, then Catholic, then priest and bishop as well as a founder of a religious order. Later he was named a doctor of the church and a saint. The diocese did have a parish of St Monica in queens. In fact it was the 1st parish in queens. It was suppressed in the 1950s. It was at the site of the now York College in Jamaica. The facade of one of their buildings is the church entrance of St Monica church. It was in fact in our Deanery and it would be nice to resurrect her as a local intercessor in our neighborhood again. Plus like St Gianna he was a mom who said yes like Mary and struggled for her children.

-Blessed Carlo

As we are in this Eucharistic Renewal and Blessed Carlo is a story well known to our people, with his statue in both churches for intercession and prayer his place as our new parish intercessor makes sense. Plus one of the top concerns of the recent synod on both the deanery, diocese, and international level is reaching out to youth and inviting them back to church. What better way to do that then to ask the intercession of a young saint who loved the Eucharist, loved being Catholic

Please pray about it and let me know if, in prayer, any names come to heart. I need to send the names in to the Bishop by the Feast of the Immaculate Conception.

MENSAJE DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO, 3 DE DICIEMBRE DE 2023

Como parte del proceso de fusión, el Obispo Brennan ha pedido sugerencias para el nuevo nombre de la nueva parroquia. Ambas iglesias mantendrán siempre su nombre e identidad, la Encarnación será siempre la Iglesia de la Encarnación y el Santuario de San Gerardo de Majella será siempre un Santuario, pero la nueva parroquia unida corporativa/canónica tendrá su propio nombre. (La Academia de la Encarnación tampoco cambiará su nombre ni su estructura de gobierno en este proceso). Al final será el Obispo Brennan quien decide el nombre, pero me ha pedido mi opinión. Así que les pido a todos su opinión, oración e ideas sobre posibles nuevos intercesores.

El criterio del Obispo Brennan para esto es un nombre, o evento, y una explicación de porque construiría la identidad de ambos sitios y personas. Recuerden que esta nueva parroquia será nuestra identidad pública exterior durante cientos de años y no debe ser un nombre que ya exista actualmente como parroquia en nuestra diócesis. Existe la posibilidad de que se elija Encarnación-San Gerardo como nombre. Pero quería que se hicieran más elecciones a través de la oración. Algunos nombres que se me ocurrieron en la oración y algunos que otros sugirieron hasta ahora son:

Santa Gianna Molla: Es una santa de los años 1960-70 que fue canonizada por San Juan Pablo II a finales de los años 1990. Era una esposa y madre italiana. Doctora de profesión. Una mujer laica muy activa en su parroquia que dirigía estudios bíblicos y ayudaba en la preparación para el matrimonio y la educación religiosa. Al concebir a su último hijo, su médico le dijo que algo iba muy mal y que abortaba o moriría poco después del parto. Como era médico, comprendió la biología y la ciencia y aceptó la realidad de la situación. Después de rezar con su esposo, sus hijos y sacerdotes locales, eligieron la vida. Eligió tener su niña. Pocos días después de que la niña naciera sana, la madre falleció. Esa niña –también con el nombre de su madre Gianna- está viva. También el esposo y los hijos de Gianna Molla, están vivos y, hablan del poderoso testimonio, la vocación y la intercesión desde el cielo de Gianna. Santa Gianna es patrona de la vida y, por tanto, al igual que María, dijo sí a la vida y está vinculada a San Gerardo como intercesora por las mujeres embarazadas.

Nuestro Salvador: Simplemente, Jesús Nuestro Señor. No puede haber mayor intercesor.


Santa Mónica: Ella fue la madre de San Agustín, Obispo y Doctor de la Iglesia del siglo IV. Ella rezó por la conversión moral y espiritual de sus hijos, tuvo dos. Ambos se convirtieron. Agustín cuando era ateo que llevaba una vida moral muy cuestionable pasó a ser cristiano, luego católico, después sacerdote y obispo, así como fundador de una orden religiosa. Más tarde fue nombrado doctor de la Iglesia y santo. La diócesis tenía una parroquia de Santa Mónica en Queens. De hecho fue la primera parroquia de Queens. Fue suprimida en la década de 1950 y estaba en el lugar del actual York College en Jamaica. La fachada de uno de sus edificios es la entrada de la iglesia de Santa Mónica. De hecho estaba en nuestro decanato y sería bonito resucitarla de nuevo como intercesora local en nuestro barrio. Además como santa Gianna fue una mamá que dijo sí como María y luchó por sus hijos.

Beato Carlo: Como estamos en la actualidad en una Renovación Eucarística y, la vida del Beato Carlo es muy conocida por nuestra gente por su amor a la Eucaristía; en ambas iglesias tenemos una estatua de él y siempre estamos pidiendo su intercesión y oración. Creo que el nombre del Beato Carlo como nuestro nuevo intercesor parroquial tiene sentido. Además, una de las principales preocupaciones del reciente sínodo, tanto a nivel de decanato como diocesano e internacionalmente, es llegar a los jóvenes e invitarles a volver a la iglesia. ¿Qué mejor manera de hacerlo que pedir la intercesión de un santo joven contemporáneo que amaba la Eucaristía, amaba ser católico...?

Por favor, recen sobre ello y háganmelo saber. Y, si en su oración, algún nombre viene a su mente y a su corazón, déjelo saber pronto. Necesito enviar los nombres al Obispo antes de la Fiesta de la Inmaculada Concepción.
