



Am I perfect? No! but it is not like I am not trying; and I have enough skills to communicate in Spanish and that is what matters.

I have also taken some courses in French in case I need to celebrate the Haitian mass. Fr Rodnev, also, is fluent in both Spanish and French. He has been studying them for more than 16 years. We do our best to bring the sacraments to the people who we love. Can we learn more? Yes, everyone can. But we do our best with what we have.

Getting outside priests to solve our vocation issues is only a bandaid. It will not fix the long-term issues of staffing parishes. Also, there is a vocation shortage in many parishes in Latin America so that is not fair for the local churches there to send all their priests here to solve our issues.


We have two seminarians from our parish in the major seminary. They are also studying multiple languages as they prepare for priesthood. But we need more. 
