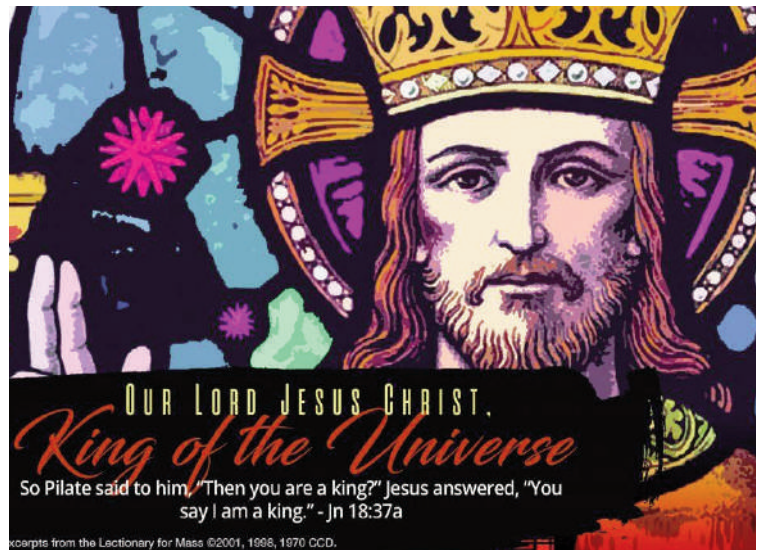

Pastor's Message

Happy Feast of Christ the King! This week, along with all the parishes of the diocese we are doing the Synod. We will be doing “listening Sessions” after the masses. Please take part, or at the very least send in your prayerful responses to the questions I put into last weeks bulletin. I want everyone’s voice heard.

The next stage of this process is that I will organize all the responses into a report that I need to submit to the proper office in the Diocese by Nov 30th. Then On Dec 14th the priests of the Deanery (the ten parishes in the area) will be meeting with our new Bishop at St. Nicks for a working prayer meeting on this topic. As part of that meeting we will have mass with Bp Brennan and then a Deanery Listening Session after the mass. I will be asking two parishioners from each church to attend that listening session with the Bishop.

Another important event that is happening is that we are ready to fully open the mass book of 2022. I met with the Parish Pastoral Council on Monday via zoom and we reviewed the next years mass calendar. Essentially, on civil holidays we will have only one mass at one of the churches. (like on 4th of July or Memorial day instead of mass at each church we will only have one mass that day). Also if a snow day is declared, schools go on zoom, office closed and it’s a mess outside and the city says people should stay home, we will not have the morning mass at incarnation, rather we will have two masses at St. Gerard. This is so the priests will not endanger themselves to drive in a storm when the city says its dangerous to do. Mass and that intention will still happen and we will live stream it, but we will keep incarnation buildings locked up so it can be cleaned and so everyone will be safe. If that is the case we will put the notice up on Facebook and on the parish websites the night before. Assume if the school is closed (goes to remote learning) then the office will be closed that day and mass will happen at SGM and that for your own safety you should not come to the mass on that day.

Lastly, please continue to fill out the Stewardship Census Cards so that as we update our data it is a accurate as it can be.

Mensaje de Parroco

¡Feliz Fiesta de Cristo Rey! Esta semana, junto con todas las parroquias de la Diócesis estamos haciendo el Sínodo. Haremos "sesiones de escucha" después de las misas. Por favor, participen, o al menos envíen sus respuestas en oración a las preguntas que puse en el boletín de la semana pasada. Quiero que se escuche la voz de todos.

La siguiente etapa de este proceso es que voy a organizar todas las respuestas en un informe que tengo que presentar a la oficina apropiada en la Diócesis para el 30 de noviembre. El 14 de diciembre, los sacerdotes del decanato (las diez parroquias de la zona) se reunirán con nuestro nuevo obispo en St. Nicolás para una reunión de oración sobre este tema. Como parte de esa reunión tendremos una misa con el Obispo Brennan y luego una sesión de escucha del Decanato después de la misa. Pediré a dos feligreses de cada iglesia que asistan a esa sesión de escucha con el Obispo.

Otro evento importante que está sucediendo es que estamos listos para abrir completamente el libro de MISAS para el año 2022. Me reuní con el Consejo Pastoral Parroquial el lunes por

medio de Zoom y revisamos el calendario de misas para el próximo año. Esencialmente, en los días festivos civiles tendremos una sola misa en una de las iglesias, (como el 4 de julio o el Día de Recordación/*Memorial Day* en lugar de misa en cada iglesia sólo tendremos una misa ese día). También si se declara una nevada, las clases escolares serán a distancia, la oficina estará cerrada y si es un desastre afuera y la ciudad indica que la gente debe permanecer en casa, no vamos a tener la misa de la mañana en la parroquia de la Encarnación, más bien tendremos dos misas en San Gerardo. Esto es para que los sacerdotes no se arriesguen a conducir en una tormenta cuando la ciudad dice que es peligroso hacerlo. La misa y la intención se mantendrán y habrá una transmisión en vivo, pero mantendremos los edificios de la Encarnación cerrados para que puedan ser limpiados y para que todos estén seguros.

Si este es el caso, pondremos el aviso en Facebook y en las páginas web de la parroquia la noche anterior. Asumiendo que la escuela estará cerrada (la enseñanza se hará a distancia), también la oficina estará cerrada ese día y la misa tendrá lugar en la San Gerardo de Majella y, por favor, por su propia seguridad no deben venir a la misa ese día.

Por último, por favor, sigan rellenando las Tarjetas del Censo de la Mayordomía para que al actualizar nuestros datos, los mismos sean lo más precisos que se pueda.

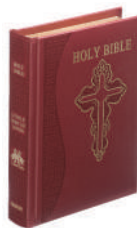
